FORESTRY FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION GOVERNOR'S SCHOOL FOR AGRICULTURE

The Forestry Foundation's Governor's School For Agriculture Scholarship is designed to assist in pursuing higher education or training for a future profession in the wood supply chain.

To qualify, candidates must be a citizen of South Carolina, maintain a 2.0 GPA or better, and graduating in the Spring of 2024.

Scholarships are awarded based on academic performance, financial need,

and commitment to future employment in the wood supply chain.

One scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 will be awarded to a deserving student.

The Forestry Foundation must receive the following from each applicant by March 31, 2024:

- A 1-2 page essay describing why the applicant should be considered for the scholarship. Include <u>complete contact information</u> at the top of the essay.
- A recent high resolution head-and-shoulders photograph.
- A copy of the applicant's latest official transcript or equivalent.
- Full contact information for at least two references.
