Affiliates: The network of county landowner associations provides outreach to a broader segment of the forestry community.

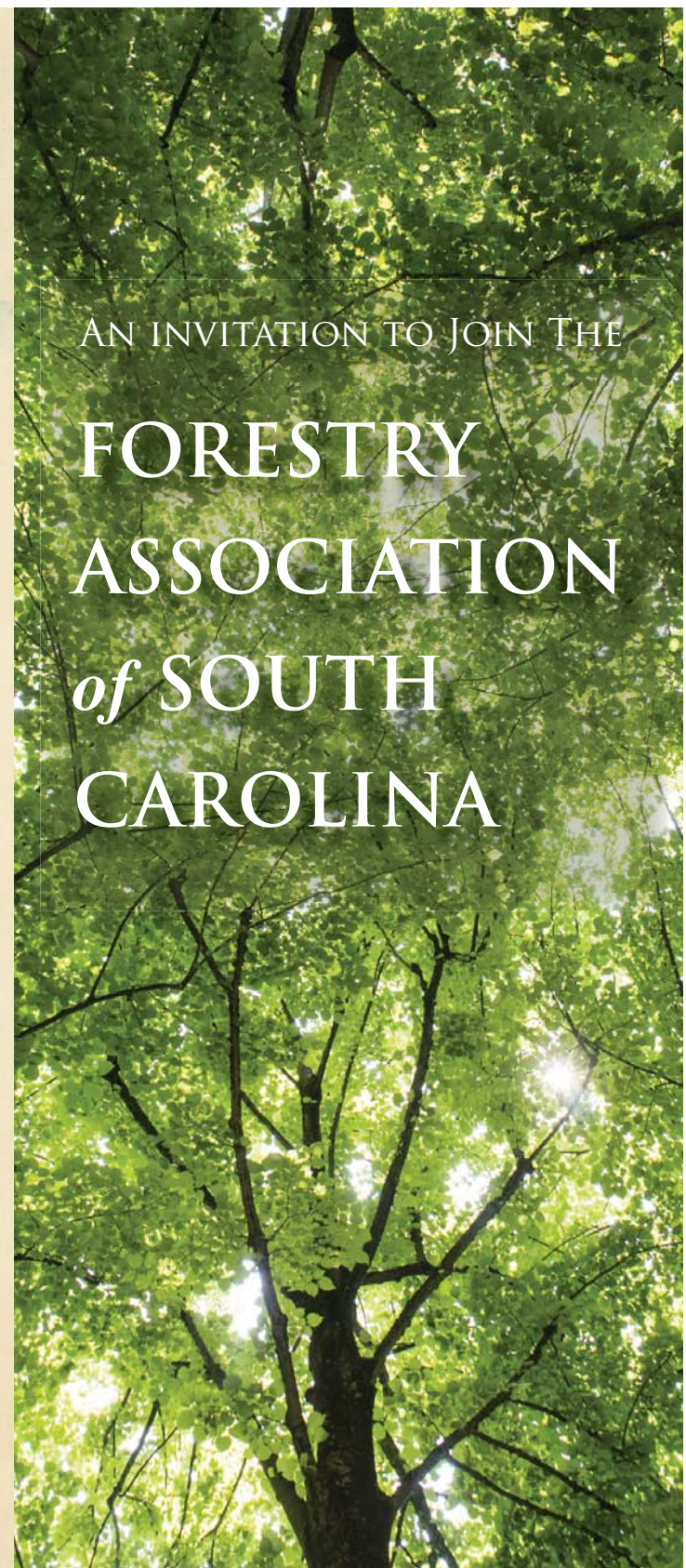
