



SC Project Learning Tree (PLT) offers professional development (PD) in in-person, blended (virtual & in-person), and virtual formats. Our state program currently has grant funding to offer trainings **-free of charge-** to pre-service educators studying education, students majoring in natural resources, in-service educators, and early childhood educators registered through DSS. The funded trainings can be offered to these individuals if their associated college, school, district, or center requests a PD event. Regular open-to-the-public PLT workshops require a \$20 per participant fee.
