Developed with preschool educators and early childhood specialists, PLT's Environmental Experiences for Early Childhood is specifically designed for educators who work with children ages three to six. This program builds on children's sense of wonder about nature and provides an early foundation for developing positive impressions about nature and lifelong social and academic skills.

Participants will first partake in a 1.5 hour live video conference in which they will get acquainted with the South Carolina state program, learn about helpful online resources, and participate in two PLT activities. They will then get access to an electronic copy of the activity guide and the accompanying online professional development training, which will be completed individually.
