### Teaching students how to think, not what to think!

Project Learning Tree has a variety of secondary modules designed to help meet the needs of educators and anyone working with students in grades 9-12 (can be adapted for grades 6-8). The secondary modules are designed to meet common components of national and state education reforms by using whole language teaching, cooperative learning, problem solving and authentic assessments.

Educators completing this workshop will receive 3 different modules. The [Exploring Environmental Issues: Focus on Forests](#) module is designed to foster student understanding of — and appreciation for — the forested lands throughout North America. The module’s activities provide an opportunity for hands-on study of forest resources while addressing concepts in biology, civics, ecology, economics, forest management, and other subject areas. The [Global Connections: Forests of the World](#) module was developed by Project Learning Tree in partnership with the World Forestry Center. The module’s activities provide students with opportunities to apply scientific processes and higher order thinking skills while investigating world forestry issues and conducting service-learning action projects. The [Southeastern Forests and Climate Change](#) module helps educators in the Southeast teach about climate change impacts on forest ecosystems, the role of forests in sequestering carbon, and strategies for reducing greenhouse gas emissions and adapting to changing climatic conditions.
